2 Nominal Morphology

Plurality is expressed by total reduplication.

3 Verbal Morphology

The verb agrees in person and number with the subject. There is an inclusive/exclusive distinction in 1PL. The form of 3SG equals the one for 3PL.

4 Conjunction

The conjunctions are *ʔel* 'and', and *pe* 'and, but'. The clitic/preposition *mtul-* 'with' can be used to express coordination as well.

- (1) *mús ɣ-scqéq̄λn pe cq°əcécəs.*

'Four times I shot, and it started off.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 135]

- (2) *pəλkyéʔe-kp, pe táʔ ws k-smyméys nʔélye k-mútəs.*

'You have a grandmother, but she doesn't live near here.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 135]

- (3) ckícx mt-k°sélktns.

'He came with his friends.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 147]

'He stood up and took a look.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 147]

'Yonder one, that one and this one.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]

'I, too, am going to take a sweat bath.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]

'He, too, is going to take a sweat bath.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
- (9) flú? ?eλ γ-(m-)w?é?xwn

'I was there too.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
- (10) séswncłp ?eλ me? q°əcécəp
?
'Ask (pl.) me before you go. (lit. Ask me and then you'll go.)' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
- (11) me? wíkcn ?eλ me? f?ékəx°
?
'I'll see you before you go.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
- (12) q?és ?eλ k°əx° pətk°nwehtməs
?
'It took us a long time drilling through. (lit. It was a long time and then we managed to drill through it.)' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
- (13) p?éx° pyín γ-scéłts ?eλ pəxyéwt

'It is colder now than yesterday.' [Kuipers, 1974, p. 276]
