2 Nominal Morphology

Plurality is expressed by total reduplication.

3 Verbal Morphology

The verb agrees in person and number with the subject. There is an inclusive/exclusive distinction in 1PL. The form of 3SG equals the one for 3PL.

4 Conjunction

The conjunctions are $2e\lambda$ 'and', and pe 'and, but'. The clitic/preposition $mtu\lambda$ - 'with' can be used to express coordination as well.
